| Level I: Evaluation and renewal of current lenses. | (1) Previous patient who is happy with their current lenses; or (2) New patient who is happy in their current lenses AND has a complete copy of their prescription (current or expired). | (1) Evaluation of your current contact lenses and the health of your eyes, with special attention to the effect of the lenses on your corneas and lids. (2) Any follow-up visits related to contact lens fitting or problems for a 6 month period from the initial date of fitting. | \$55 |
| Level II: Simple re-fit; Spherical or Aspheric re-fit. | (1) Patient who has successfully worn contact lenses in the past but is having trouble with their current lenses, or (2) Patient who needs contact lenses and does not have a prescription for them (current or expired). | (1) Initial fit and evaluation of your new contact lenses and the health of your eyes, with special attention to the effect of the lenses on your corneas and lids. (2) All trial contact lenses. (3) All follow-up visits related to contact lens fitting or problems for a 6 month period from the initial date of fitting (usually 1-2). | \$75 |
| Level III: Complex re-fit; Bifocal, Toric, or Rigid Gas Permeable re-fit. | (1) Patient who has successfully worn contact lenses in the past, but is having trouble with their current lenses, or (2) Patient who needs contact lenses and does not have a prescription for them (current or expired). | (1) Initial fit and evaluation of your new contact lenses and the health of your eyes, with special attention to the effect of the lenses on your corneas and lids. (2) All trial contact lenses and a contact lens solution starter kit including new case. (3) All follow-up visits related to contact lens fitting or problems for a 6 month period from the initial date of fitting (usually 2-3) | \$105 |
| Level IV: Simple new fit; Spherical or Aspheric fit. | (1) Patient who has never worn contact lenses before, or (2) Patient who has not worn them successfully and needs training. | (1) Initial fit and evaluation of your new contact lenses and the health of your eyes, with special attention to the effect of the lenses on your corneas and lids. (2) All trial contact lenses and a contact lens solution starter kit including new case. (3) All follow-up visits related to contact lens fitting or problems for a 6 month period from the initial date of fitting (usually 2-3). (4) Training by our expert contact lens staff. | \$125 |
| Level V: Complex new fit; Bifocal, Toric, or Rigid Gas Permeable fit. | (1) Patient who has never worn contact lenses before, or (2) patient who has not worn them successfully, needs training, AND has special needs such as astigmatism, presbyopia, or prefers a Rigid Gas Permeable lens, or (3) Corneal rehabilitation. | (1) Initial fit and evaluation of your new contact lenses and the health of your eyes, with special attention to the effect of the lenses on your corneas and lids. (2) All trial contact lenses, starter kit. (3) All follow-up visits related to contact lens fitting or problems for a 6 month period from the initial date of fitting (usually 2-5). (4) Training by our expert contact lens staff. | \$150 and up |
